6 New Ways To Play!

Fun rules for any of these groups:

FAMILY **FRIENDS** **YOUNG MARRIEDS**

SAMPLE BELOW: HOW TO PLAY WITH YOUR **FAMILY!**

When to Play: Home Evening, Sunday Afternoon, Game Night, Reunion, Dinner

How to Play:

- Players ages 6-100 can play. Sit in a circle.
- Shuffle the “Did You Know...” cards.
- Youngest player goes first. Play goes clockwise.
- Roll the die, get connected, and have FUN!
 - If you roll 1: You draw a question and answer it.
 - If you roll 2: Players on your sides answer your question.
 - If you roll 3: Play “Paper, Rock, and Scissors” with a person of your choice to see who answers the question.
 - If you roll 4: Aim the card at a person of your choice and flip the card... question is answered by the person closest to where the card lands.
 - If you roll 5: Take three cards off the top of the deck. Holding the cards face down, choose a person to draw one of the cards and he/she answers it.
 - If you roll 6: Give a true answer and a false answer. The group tries to guess which one is true.
- -OR- Make up your own rules
